

NIGERIA: In May, CBSI Nigeria C&Y Supervisor Mercy reported that Children & Youth Ministry would soon be starting at 12 new churches and schools and that three locations would be restarting. C&Y training was held at a local church in Jos. Under capable national leadership, God has favored C&Y in Nigeria with 80 percent growth in June alone! C&Y went from 2,113 students to 3,810 students in one month! Please pray for the class leaders who are discipling young Nigerians through the Word of God.
